Residences will boast superb views and outstanding design, including high-quality craftsmanship, meticulous attention to detail and the finest finishes, such as bespoke kitchens by Poggenpohl. Residences range in price from \$1,150,000 to \$37.5 million for a 12,846-square-foot penthouse occupying the entire 60th floor.
