**MILLENNIUM TOWER BOSTON,
1 FRANKLIN STREET**

Given its scale, Millennium Tower Boston could be better described as a vertical neighbourhood than an apartment block. The 60-storey tower in downtown Boston, developed by Millennium Partners, includes 442 apartments and a range of amenities such as restaurants and recreational areas. The first residents moved into the landmark building this summer and it is now 95 per cent sold.

Designed by Blake Middleton of Handel Architects, the glass-and-steel modernist monolith stands in contrast to the ornamental Beaux Arts-style Burnham Building next door. The 104-year-old building was restored as part

of the Millennium Tower Boston project and is home to a variety of shops that residents might find handy. Within the tower itself, they will be able to dine at Michelin-starred chef Michael Mina's Mina at the Tower, which forms part of a two-level residents' club with a communal lounge and a health club with swimming pool. In addition, Mina and sushi chef Ken Tominaga have opened an izakaya and sushi bar, Pabu, in the tower.

With the interior designed by Christopher Peacock, there are still one-, two- and three-bedroom apartments available, from 759sqft, and penthouses that sprawl across 13,000sqft.
